Prayer Focus: Lord, purify my heart and burn away anything that does not honor You.

Reflection: Where is God calling you to live more consecrated?

Scripture: 2 Timothy 1:6

Prayer Focus: Father, awaken every dormant gift in me. Stir what You've placed inside me.

Prayer Focus: Give me the courage to walk into new areas of obedience and influence.

Reflection: Where is God asking you to move forward in faith?

Scripture: Psalm 92:10

"You have exalted my horn like that of a wild ox; fine oils have been poured on me."

Prayer Focus: Lord, anoint me afresh. Let Your Spirit empower me again.

Reflection: When was the last time you were refreshed in His presence?

Reflection: What needs to shift in your schedule or life priorities?
